Here are the options from which you can choose your favourite:

1. Langham Mews

The name is inspired by The Langham Cinema which opened in 1936 on the site of the current Lidl Supermarket at the top of Bridge Street.

2. Pinnora Mews

The Old English name for Pinner first recorded in 1231 as Pinnora, although the already archaic -ora (meaning 'hill') suggests its origins lie no later than circa 900.

3. Horatia Mews

The daughter of Lord Nelson, who is buried in Pinner cemetery.

4. Pinn Mews

The River Pinn, which runs through the middle of Pinner.

5. Edward Lear Mews

The famous Poet referred to Pinner in a poem in the 1800s.
