The Harrow (Waiting and Loading Restrictions) (Amendment No. *) Traffic Order 202*

- 1. Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Harrow proposes to make the above-mentioned Order under Sections 6 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.
- 2. The general effect of the Order would be further to amend the Harrow (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 2014 so that:
 - a. waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) would be prohibited at any time in the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice;
 - b. waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) would be prohibited between 8.00a.m. and 9.00a.m. and 3.00p.m. and 4.00p.m. Monday to Friday in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice;
 - c. waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) would be prohibited between 8.00a.m. and 9.30a.m. and 4.30p.m. and 6.30p.m. Monday to Friday in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 3 to this Notice;
 - d. waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) would be prohibited between 7.00a.m. and 7.00p.m. Monday to Saturday in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 4 to this Notice;
 - e. loading by vehicles would be prohibited at any time in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 5 to this Notice;
 - f. loading by vehicles would be prohibited between 7.00a.m. and 7.00p.m. Monday to Saturday in the lengths of the road specified in Schedule 6 to this Notice.
- 3. The restrictions referred to in this Notice would not apply in respect of anything done at the direction of a police constable in uniform or with the permission of a civil enforcement officer or other person authorised by the Council or in certain circumstances, such as the picking up or setting down of passengers, or the carrying out of statutory powers or duties.
- 4. A copy of the proposed Orders, of a map of the relevant area and of the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Orders can be inspected until the expiration of a period of 21 days from the date on which this notice is published online at www.harrow.gov.uk/trafficorders or alternatively at Greenhill Library, Perceval Square, College Road, Harrow, HA1 1GX between 10.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. Monday to Saturday.

Sheepcote Road, the service road between servicing Chester Court, Shepherds Court and Tempsford Court, the northern arm, the north side, the south side, between its northern extremity and a point 1.80m south-east of the common boundary of Nos. 16 and 17 Chester Court, between a point 2.00m north-west of the common boundary of Nos. 15 and 16 Chester Court and it its southern extremity. The eastern arm, between its northern extremity and a point 8.50m south-east of that point. The western arm, the north-western side, the south-eastern side, between its north-eastern extremity and a point 4.30m south-west of the south-western kerb-line of the eastern arm, between the south-western wall of Shepherds Court and its junction with Sheepcote Road. Stiven Crescent, the northwest side, between a point 9.00m north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Veldene Way and a point 10.00m southwest of the south-western kerb-line of Veldene Way. St. John's Road, the service road between Nos. 13 and 15 St. John's Road. Stonegrove Gardens, the south-west and south-east side, between a point 2.90m south-west of the eastern wall of Nos. 1-3 Stonegrove Gardens and the south-western wall of Nos. 12, 14 and 16 Stonegrove Gardens, the north to south arm, the north-eastern side, between the kerb-line of Stonegrove Gardens and a point 4.30m south of that kerb-line, the south-western side, between the kerb-line of Stonegrove Gardens and a point 2.00m south-east of that kerb-line. Veldene Way, between the north-western kerb-line of Stiven Crescent and a point 9.00m north-west of that kerb-line.

SCHEDULE 2 - Courtens Mews, the west and south-west side, between a point 1.60m south-east of the north-western wall of No. 8 Stuart Cottages, Belmont Lane and a point 3.50m south of the common boundary of Nos. 1 and 2 Courtens Mews, between the common boundary of Nos. 4 and 5 Courtens Mews and a point 3.10m south of the common boundary of Nos. 5 and 6 Courtens Mews, between a point 2.10m north of the common boundary of Nos. 7 and 8 Courtens Mews and a point 7.4m north of the north-western wall of No. 8 Courtens Mews, between a point 4.70m south of the common boundary of Nos. 17 and 18 Courtens Mews and a point 1.30m north of that common boundary, between a point 2.70m south of the northern boundary of No. 18 Courtens Mews and a point 4.00m north of the northern boundary of No. 18 Courtens Mews. The north-east and east side, between a point 2.50m north-west of the south-eastern wall of No. 8 Stuart Cottages. Belmont Lane and a point 0.90m north-west of the south-eastern wall of No. 5 Courtens Mews.

SCHEDULE 3 - Eastcote Lane, the north and north-east sides, between a point 1.20m north-east of the common boundary of Nos. 401 and 403 Eastcote Lane and a point 0.50m north-east of the north-eastern wall of No. 397 Eastcote Lane.

SCHEDULE 4 - Pinner View, the east side, between a point 12.00m north of the north-western kerb-line of Victor Road and a point 14.00m north-west of the north-western wall of No. 88-90 Victor Road, between a point 28.50m north-west of the north-mestern boundary of No. 149 Pinner View.

SCHEDULE 5 - Honeypot Lane, the east side, between a point 3.90m south-east of the common boundary of Nos. 408 and 410 Honeypot Lane and a point 3.60m south-east of the common boundary of Nos. 412 and 414 Honeypot Lane. **SCHEDULE 6 - Pinner View**, the south-west side, between a point 9.00 metres south-east of the south-eastern kerb-line of Victor Road and a point 8.00 metres north-west of the north-western property line of No. 149 Pinner View.
